This is the focus of Project Ewikkendaswat Ekenomagewat, a three-year language revitalization project to provide language instructor skills training during the academic school year and summer language immersion camps each summer to participants. These individuals have committed to learn, speak and teach the Potawatomi language for future generations.



Hannahville training participants are joined by other Potawatomi communities to absorb, learn and speak the language with fluent speakers/elders. Mornings are spent with the speakers, while afternoons are filled with planned language activities to practice and speak language learned during the morning sessions.
