Potawatomi Personal Pronouns

Potawatomi pronouns are used to place special emphasis on a person:

nin	I
gin	you
win	he, she, or it
ninan	we, but not you
ginan	we all
ginwa	you all
winwa	they

Nin, nwi-maji. *As for me, I am leaving.*

I she an we, **gin** je? Everything is okay, and you?
