Mko gises	<i>Bear Moon</i>
Ni tthe pi wa odanke yen?	<i>When are you going to town?</i>
Wabek ge zhep nwi odanke.	<i>Tomorrow morning I'm going to town.</i>
Ni tthe pi wa odanke yek?	<i>When are you (pl) going to town?</i>
Odanke gishgek nwi odankemen	<i>We're going to town on Saturday</i>
Shwatso dbegenek nwi odanke.	<i>I'm going to town at eight o'clock.</i>
Ni tthe e pi tthiyak i eda yen?	<i>How far is it to your house?</i>
Be shooth yawen. <i>(rare occasion for double vowel)</i>	<i>It is close by.</i>
Ni tthe ga kedot?	<i>What did he say?</i>
Notth gezhiwen.	<i>Be louder.</i>
Notth bedangedonen.	<i>Talk slower.</i>
